Six-week credit programs

You and your parents or guardians need to fill out the first pages completely (pages 33 and 34), as well as relevant sections of the High School Evaluation forms (pages 35 through 38). These materials, together with a non-refundable \$50 application fee payable to Syracuse University Summer College, must be taken to secondary school officials who will complete them confidentially and send them to us by the deadlines given below. Be sure to provide school officials with the envelope and notify them of deadlines. It is your responsibility to see that school officials submit materials by the deadline. The application fee is deducted from the total program cost. Scholarship applicants must meet additional requirements listed in the section below.

Only completed applications are considered. We recommend that you submit your application materials well before the application deadline, as popular programs fill quickly.

A complete application consists of the following components:

- I. Student Essay: Write your responses to the following questions:
 1. How did you become interested in the program of study you have selected as your program of choice if you are admitted to Summer College?
 2. What do you expect to gain from your Summer College experience?
- II. Application for admission
- III. High school recommendation
- IV. Teacher recommendation
- V. High school transcript, including current year of study
- VI. \$50 non-refundable application fee

Instructions for international students

Complete the application materials on page 39 in addition to those described above. Application deadline for international students is March 15, 2008.

Deadlines

The postmark deadline for completed applications is May 15, 2008. Earlier applications are strongly encouraged because most programs have limited enrollment. All applications are processed in the order they are received. Late applications may be accepted for programs not filled. The postmark deadline for scholarship applications is April 15, 2008. *Late applications may be considered for enrollment, but not for scholarship.*

Damage Deposit Each residential student must provide a damage deposit of \$75. This money is refunded in the fall if no damage or lost key/access card charges are assessed.

Course Materials and Additional Expenses Textbooks, lab fees, other course-related materials, and personal expenses are not included in the total. Expect to spend \$150 per course for books and materials.

Financial aid

A limited number of partial tuition scholarships are available. All scholarships are awarded based on financial need.

Financial aid application procedures

1. Complete the financial aid section on page 34.
2. Completed financial aid applications (including school evaluations) must be postmarked no later than April 15, 2008.

Payment methods and deadlines

Applicants must pay in full on or before June 20, 2008, to secure a place in the program. You may guarantee your admittance into the program of your choice by submitting a \$1,500 deposit within three weeks of receipt of your letter of acceptance, and a maximum of two additional payments for the remaining balance. This deposit is refundable until 5 p.m. on Friday, May 30, 2008. Payment must be made in U.S. currency by check, money order, MasterCard, or Visa. Applicants who plan to pay with MasterCard or Visa must complete the appropriate information on the application, page 34. Applicants who plan to pay by check should allow time for check clearance.
